Programs Qualification Time

1) International Foundation Diploma

The timetable is a two-semester model with 15 weeks per semester: 13 teaching weeks and 2 additional weeks to prepare for and conduct assessments.

Each semester will be approximately 3 months and 3 weeks. There will be 1-2 week's break after the first semester.

Applicants must normally be between 16-19 years old by 31st December in the year that they start IFD. Applicants who are 16 may be accepted in exceptional cases but such students will have limited progression options.

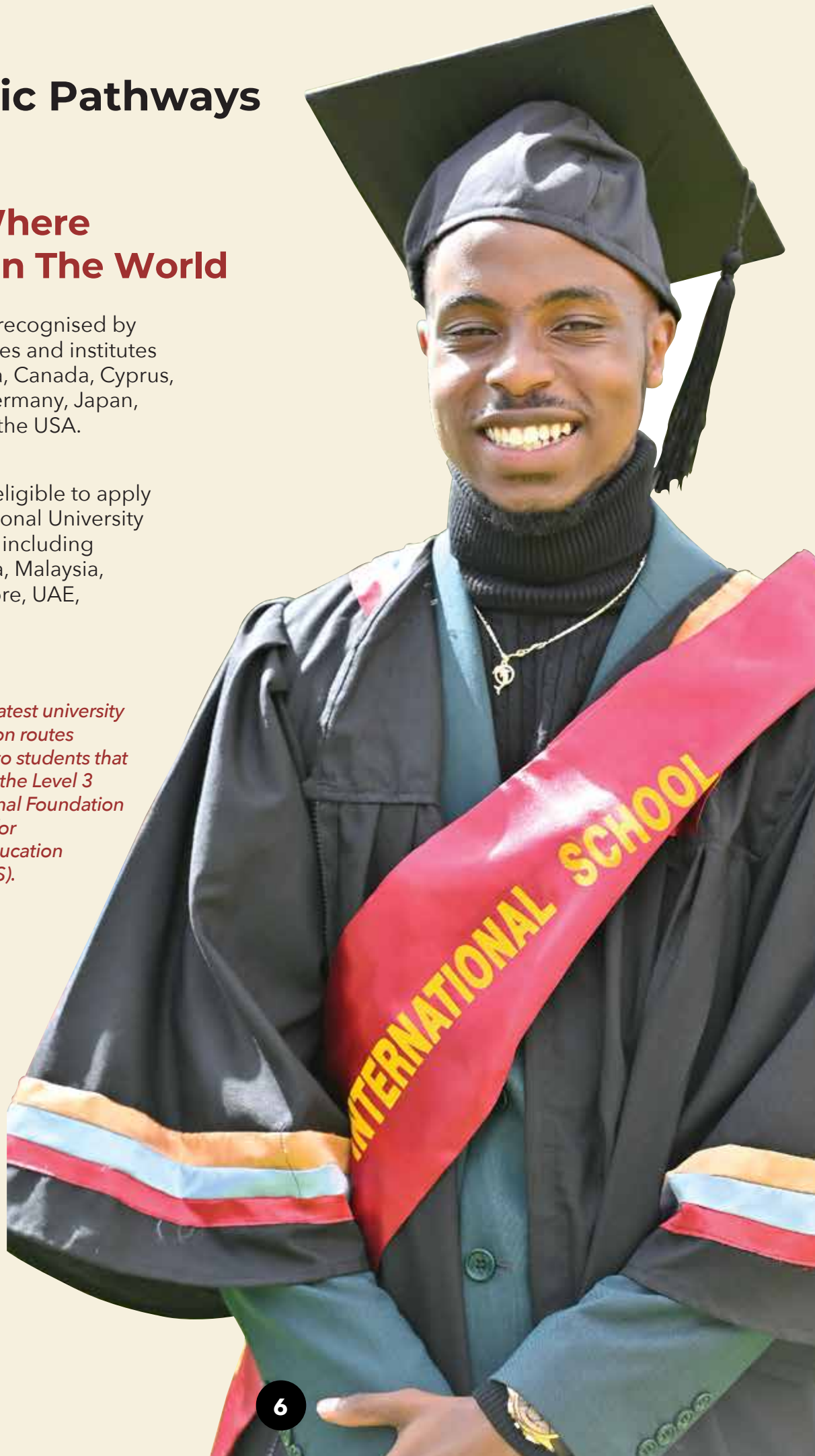

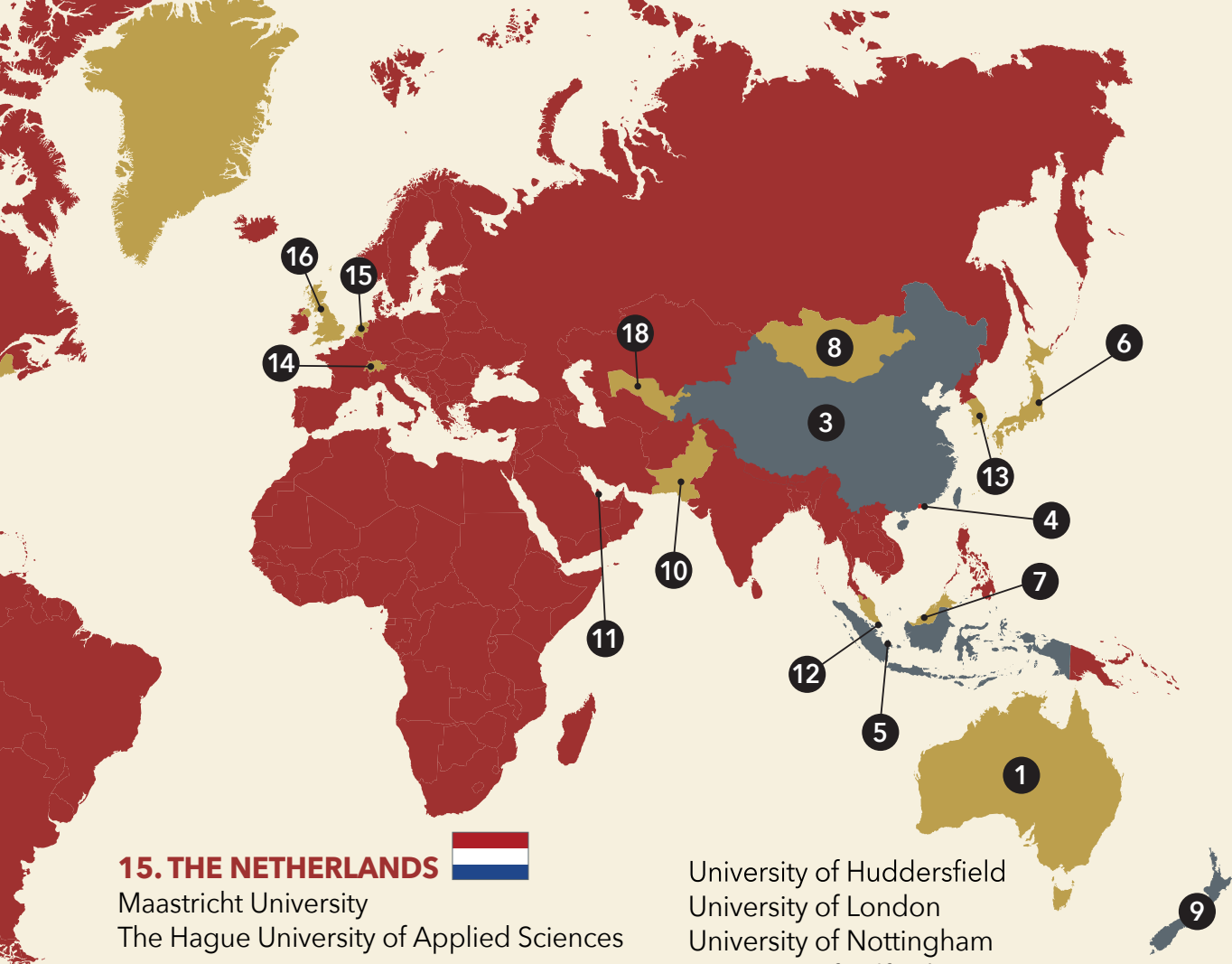

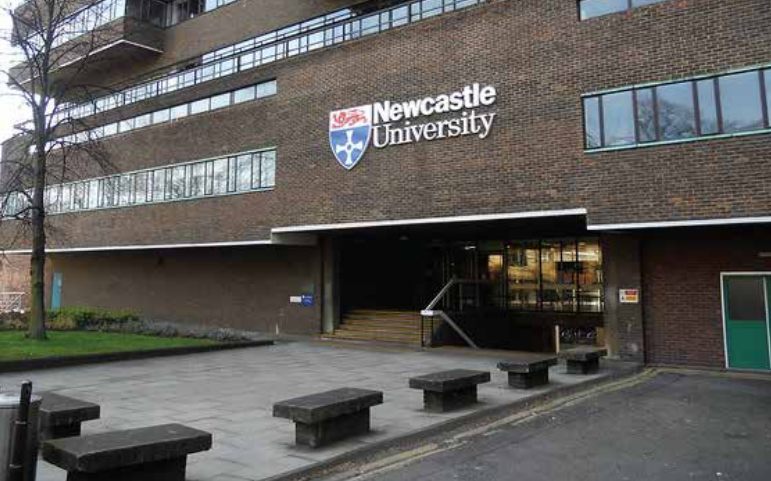

It is offered to students who are boarders or day-scholars and is available in Lavington and Kiserian Campuses.
